With our **Library at Your Door** service, we mail materials directly to you!

Who is eligible?

Salt Lake County residents, with a valid Salt Lake County Library Card, who are unable to physically visit the County Library due to illness, injury, or disability.

How do I request materials?

How do I receive my materials?

The County Library mails materials to you via the United States Postal Service (USPS) in sturdy fabric bags. A list of the materials sent, and their due dates, is included in the bag.

How do I return the materials?

Steps for returning materials are simple:

- Place the materials back into the fabric bag and zip it closed.
- Rather than returning a single item by itself, please reach out to your Library at Your Door advisor or library customer service to renew your items in order to send them back together.
- Flip the mailing label around to show the pre-paid postage (addressed to Salt Lake County Library).
- Leave the bag for your USPS carrier to pick up, schedule a pick up with USPS: <u>usps.com/ship</u>, or have someone return the bag to any of our County Library branches: <u>thecountylibrary.org/locations</u>

What is the cost for this service?

There is no cost for this service. The library pays for the shipping. There are no overdue fees. The only charges associated with this program would be fees for lost or damaged items or delivery bags. Service recipients can be sent to collections for nonpayment of fees.

What else should I know?

- Maximum number of checked-out items: 10
- Maximum number of holds: 10
- · Check-out period for DVDs: 3 weeks
- · Check-out period for all other items: 5 weeks
